# **WHAT ARE THE POTENTIAL RISKS associated with drinking alcohol in these places?**

## **Approx. time required**

5 minutes set up and 20+ minutes activity/feedback.

## **Instructions**

- ★ Please print out the sheets below.
- ★ Cut out all the cards on page 5 to create multiple sets of suggestions for the pupils to work with.
- ★ Divide pupils into groups, and each group is to be given one of the three types of suggested location.
- ★ Ask each group to write and present a press statement on behalf of Northumbria Police regarding a made up incident that has taken place. The cards are to give some basic suggestions for storyline/content. Specific details such as age, background, etc. can be created and added by the group to give more information.
- ★ Ask each group to consider which consequences young people might be at risk of when under the influence of alcohol.

**Ask a member of each group to present their press release back to the class, and then the class to consider the following:**

- ★ Who would this press release have an impact on?
- ★ Would it change anyone's life?
