



## Exploration Activity: Year 8 **RISK CARDS**

### **Approx. Time Required**

10 minutes discussion in groups and 5 minutes feedback for each group.

### **Resources**

See cards on page 2.

### **Instructions**

- ★ Please print out the sheet below, cut out all the cards, including the blanks to create multiple sets of statements for the pupils to work with.
- ★ Divide pupils into groups.
- ★ Ask each group to consider which of the risks they think young people would take when under the influence of alcohol and which risks young people would take when they are not.
- ★ Ask each group to discuss the potential consequence of each risk.
- ★ Please encourage each group to add what they think would be risks to the blank cards then discuss.
